During the meeting under the Tribal Sub Plan (TSP), goat units and battery-operated sprayers were distributed to the beneficiaries. Additionally, under the Scheduled Caste Sub Plan (SCSP),

light traps, power weeder, and two cono weeders were provided to selected farmers. The meeting featured presentations on KVK's activities for 2024-25, the release of informative folders on sunflower cultivation, value-added meat products and silage making, and discussions on future plans. Line Department officials and farmers offered valuable feedback. The session concluded with the felicitation of SAC members and closing remarks by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, PVNRTVU.
