TENDER DOCUMENT FOR SETTING UP OF VETERINARY PHARMACY

Tenders are invited from experienced and reputed firms/agencies/organizations for setting up of Veterinary Pharmacy at Veterinary Clinical Complex, College of Veterinary Science, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad (herein after called as College), a constituent college of P. V. Narsimha Rao Telangana Veterinary University (herein after called University).

Veterinary Clinical Complex (VCC) is a Teaching Veterinary Hospital with state-of-the-art treatment and diagnostic facilities for pet and farm animals. With an annual out-patient turnout of about 60,000 animals, this hospital is also a referral centre for advanced treatment. The hospital has a well-equipped diagnostic laboratory with facilities such as endoscopy, echocardiography, digital radiology, ultrasonography etc. It is proposed to have a Veterinary Pharmacy on the campus for the convenience of animal owners.

Bids are to be submitted under two bid system

1. Sealed Technical bid (Annexure – I) along with EMD of Rs. 3.0 Lakhs by way of Demand draft in favour of Associate Dean, C.V.Sc, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad, Super scribing “Technical Bid for Veterinary Pharmacy”.
2. Sealed financial bid (Annexure - II) super- scribing “Financial Bid for Veterinary Pharmacy”

Bids are to be submitted to the Associate Dean, College of Veterinary Science, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad – 500030.

I. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

1. Bidder should have at least **3 years** of experience of running a Veterinary Pharmacy and confirmation of previous experience will be adjudged by demanding last three years ITRs / GST statements/Retail Drug License at the time of applying for tender.
2. Bidder should be in possession of valid drug license from Telangana Drug Control Administration authorized to sell Veterinary Drugs.
3. Bidder should have valid GST registration and PAN number in the name of Firm.
4. Bidder should neither have been black listed by any Central/State government departments in the last five years nor should have any litigation pending with any of these departments.
5. Financial Capability: The applicant shall submit an annual Turn over statement for not less than Rs. 30.0 lakhs along with an Audited financial statement turnover certificate form Chartered Accountant (CA) for the last 3 consecutive financial years.

Note:

- a. *The offers submitted in any manner other than specified above will not be considered. No further correspondence will be entertained in this matter.*
- b. *Bids shall be valid for 180 days from the last date for submission.*
- c. *Bids not complying with the clauses in this document are liable to be rejected.*
- d. ***Bids received with technical and financial bids in same envelop will be summarily rejected.***
- e. *Failure to furnish all information required by the tender Document shall result in the rejection of the bid.*
- f. ***The College can annul the Tender process at any time/stage and reject all bids at any time/stage prior to award of Contract.***
- g. *Bids received after the last date & time prescribed will be summarily rejected. The College will not be responsible for any postal delay or non-receipt/non-delivery of the bid. No further correspondence will be entertained on the subject.*

** In the event of the specified last date for submission of bids being declared a holiday for UNIVERSITY, the bids will be received up to the prescribed time on the next working day.*

II. OPENING AND EVALUATION OF BIDS

Technical Bid will be opened on **20.6.2026 at 10.30 AM**. Financial Bids of only those qualified in Technical Bid will be opened on **22.6.2026 at 10.30 AM** and the tender will be allotted to the highest bidder. **Minimum license fee to be quoted shall be Rs. 1,50,000 per month (TDS @ 2%).**

Venue for opening of bids will be the Committee Room, College of Veterinary Science, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad. Bids will be opened in the presence of bidders/authorized representative present at the designated time. If any bidder is not present at the time of the opening of technical/financial bids he/she cannot challenge the proceedings of the bid opening.

III. DEED OF LICENSE

Qualifying bidder shall sign a Deed of License, primarily for fair trade practices in all dealings, incorporating tender terms, delivery mechanisms and penalties for default. The deed of license shall be signed within seven days of communication of acceptance of the bid by the College by email/WhatsApp/SMS failing which the EMD of the bidder shall be forfeited and opportunity may be extended to the next technically qualified bidder quoting second highest bid.

IV. PERIOD OF LICENSE

1. The awardee shall open the above said Veterinary Pharmacy within 30 days from the execution of a Deed of License to be signed between the college and the awardee. If under any circumstances the licensee doesn't open the

Veterinary Pharmacy within the stipulated period, the contract shall be cancelled and awarded to the next highest bidder.

2. The License shall be initially for a period of eleven months, commencing from the date of opening of Veterinary Pharmacy. Subject to satisfactory outcome of review and evaluation by the College, this deed can be extended up to a maximum period of 3 years after successful evaluation every 11 months. The license fee, in case of renewal shall be hiked by 10% after every 11 months.
3. If at any point of time, the licensee wishes to withdraw from the agreement he / she shall inform the Associate Dean of the College six months in advance. If the Licensee vacates the premises without any notice, the Refundable Security Deposit equivalent to the rent of six months deposited by him will be forfeited.
4. If the College wants to terminate the contract, the Licensee will be issued a notice two months in advance.
5. License deed can be terminated by mutual consent of the parties, if either of the parties by giving one month prior notice in writing mentioning the reasons, come to the conclusion that it is not in their interest to run the said Veterinary Pharmacy under this licensing arrangement.

V. TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Payment Terms

a. College shall provide an appropriate space to the licensee to run the Veterinary Pharmacy and in lieu thereof the licensee shall deposit license fee to the **Associate Dean, CVSc, Rajendranagar** within first seven days of every calendar month. In case of default of payment, he/she will be charged a penalty of Rs. 1500 per day of delay in payment, and a maximum of 15 days of delay may be permitted. Thereafter, outstanding amount of the license fees (including penalty) will be recovered from the security deposit of the Licensee. The College may also cancel the allotment of the Veterinary Pharmacy.

b. Payment of different types of applicable taxes from time to time is sole responsibility of the licensee.

c. The allottee shall deposit refundable security deposit in the form of Demand Draft in the name of **Associate Dean, College of Veterinary Science, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad** an amount **equal to six months of license fee** at the time of signing of Deed of License. The EMD paid by successful bidder will be adjusted against the Refundable Security Deposit.

2. Usage Terms:

- a. Licensee shall get the space organized and carryout the interior work/renovation of the premises at his/her own cost after getting the plans, layouts, overall design, furnishings etc. approved by the College. On expiry or termination of License, the Licensee shall not claim any cost or shall remove any permanent changes to Veterinary Pharmacy executed by him.
- b. The Licensee shall get his own Electricity sub meter installed and shall pay the actual cost of power consumed as per the tariff for commercial connection. The amount shall be remitted through a Demand Draft in the name of Associate Dean, College of Veterinary Science, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad-30 on every month.

- c. On expiry of the period or termination of the License, the licensee shall close its business and will have no right to carry on business at the allotted premises. The Licensee will remove its goods, furniture, etc. within a week and the college shall have the undisputed right to make use of the premises as per its discretion. In case the Licensee does not remove its articles and goods, the same shall be removed by the college at the risk and cost of the Licensee and the Licensee shall have no claim whatsoever on this account against the college.
- d. On expiry of the period or upon the termination of the License, if the Licensee fails to vacate or remove its material from the premises, the Licensee shall be treated as a trespasser and shall be under the liability to pay damages/penalty for such period.
- e. The licensee shall not stock any inflammable or otherwise dangerous or unethical or immoral materials and goods in the space which may cause a fire or health or any other hazard to the Hospital property, its guests, visitors, clients, faculty, staff, students, animals, animal owners/attendants, etc.
- f. The Licensee shall keep the premises clean and in orderly condition, and for this purpose, the licensee shall do whatsoever is required and desired by the college.

3. Employment Terms

- a. The Licensee shall observe and comply with all the Rules and Regulations of the Shops and Establishments Act, Employees State Insurance Act, Minimum Wages Act, Payment of Wages Act, Employees Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, Workmen's Compensation Act, and any other provisions of the Law, Rules and Regulations enforced from time to time by the State/Central Govt/local authorities or any other applicable authority.
- b. The Licensee shall be solely responsible for any act, omission, negligence, liability, charges etc. against its employees. The college in no way whatsoever shall have anything to do with the liability of the Licensee in such respect.
- c. The Licensee, the members of its staff or its representatives shall not do any act which may be derogatory to or inconsistent with the Hospital's (premises of the UNIVERSITY) reputation or cause nuisance to the management of the hospital or its patients or patient attendants, animal owners etc. At the instance of the college, the licensee shall discharge from service any employee who is charged with such misconduct or found acting in contravention of the general rules of the college/University.

4. Drugs & Medicines Terms

- a. The Licensee shall give maximum discount on all drugs, medicines, other items, etc. but not less than @ 10% discount on MRP. Range of generic medicines should be available at the Veterinary Pharmacy.
- b. The Licensee shall maintain sufficient stock of drugs, medicines, other items, etc. at all times to avoid any inconvenience to the patients, animal owners/attendants. The licensee shall also ensure that the medicines, drugs etc. dispensed are as per prescriptions of the Doctors or prescription slips given by

staff on duty. Licensee should avoid substitution of drugs, medicines on his own. However, in case of non-availability of a drug/medicine, the change may be done with the prescription of the Doctor concerned.

- c. The Licensee shall supply the drugs/medicines of standard quality. The list of drugs approved by the University Authority shall be compulsorily made available to the clients by the Licensee. In case, it is found that any particular medicine has expired or is substandard or spurious, the Licensee will be liable to be black-listed besides initiation of legal action as deemed fit by the College/University. **The College/University will not be liable for any spurious/substandard quality drug being sold by the licensee.**
- d. **Licensee should have to get a site-specific valid license from the competent authority for sale of drugs and scheduled drugs like anesthetics/opioids etc.** The Licensee shall meet all the conditions of retail Drug License granted by the State Drug Controller during the entire period of this License deed and any breach of such condition will amount to be breach of this License deed by the Licensee. The Licensee shall be responsible for any liability/action for noncompliance of the rules regulations as circulated by the State Drug Controller or any other competent authority.
- e. The quality of drugs, maintenance, hygiene and service of the Veterinary Pharmacy will be monitored by a committee constituted by the College at monthly interval and log book for the same should be maintained.
- f. Licensee shall have to regularly add in Veterinary Pharmacy those medicines which would be recommended by the hospital authorities from time to time.
- g. The Licensee shall maintain adequate storage facility for proper stocking of medicines, provision of adequate cold storage and maintenance of cold chain as prescribed by the manufacturers of such drugs.
- h. The Licensee shall be required to adopt fair business practices by exhibiting the MRP (inclusive of all taxes), discounted amount and net payable amount in the invoice/cash memo issued to the animal owner. He/she also abide by any other instructions issued by the College from time to time in this regard.
- i. The Licensee shall have to take back any unused medicines dispensed by the Veterinary Pharmacy and refund the amount to the animal owner/attendant.
- j. In the event of any complaint received from the customer or from any authority of Hospital or otherwise regarding the quality of the goods sold by the licensee, the licensee shall be entirely responsible for the same and liable for any penalty/damages or otherwise as well as compensation to the customer/University for damaging/tarnishing its repute or any other liability in this regard.
- k. The College at its own or on receipt of a complaint can cause inspection of the Veterinary Pharmacy by a committee. The said inspection procedure may include referring of some or all of the medicine samples to the testing agency/institute recognized by the State or Central Drug Control Authorities. The terms and reference of the said committee are at *Annexure III* of the Tender Document.
- l. The licensee shall use a computer software for maintaining *inter alia*, the daily sale record of Veterinary Pharmacy and shall provide printed bill mentioning

name of medicine, batch no., date of expiry, MRP of item, discount offered, etc. on the bill. The Licensee will provide the bill to all animal owners/attendants for any medicine dispensed by him.

- m. The Licensee, in connection with running the Veterinary Pharmacy in the licensed premises, will only appoint such persons e.g. pharmacists, having (i) educational/professional qualifications, experience prescribed under Drug and Cosmetics Act and the Rules made under (ii) good moral character and (iii) well behaved.
- n. The licensee shall keep open the Veterinary Pharmacy between 8.30 AM to 5.00 PM on all days in a week including Holidays failing which a suitable action will be taken and penalty will be imposed.
- o. The Licensee will not permit the use of the Veterinary Pharmacy premises for any other purpose other than the purpose of this license. The licensee shall not sublet the premises of the Veterinary Pharmacy to any individual/party/organization/company. The licensee alone and none else will be permitted to carry on business in the said premises. Any such act by the licensee shall be considered violation of agreement and the College shall have the right to terminate the license. In such circumstances, the licensee will have to settle all the outstanding dues and handover the possession of the premises duly vacated, within 7 days on receipt of such communication.
- p. In the event of licensee being prohibited from selling one or more articles in the premises because of Government Orders, or in case of any Strike, the College shall not be liable for any loss suffered by the licensee. Further, in such an event, the licensee shall not be entitled to any reduction in the license fee payable.
- q. Not with standing any other provisions contained in this document, in the eventuality of any loss/ damage caused on use of medicine, drugs, etc. sold by Licensee, the liability of the Licensee would be unlimited and will be subject to determination by appropriate authority or body. The College shall not be liable for the same in any manner, whatsoever.
- r. The licensee will have no right to contest if any product/medicine/package is provided by the College for treatment of animals.
- s. The licensee shall display prominently the license issued by the Controller of Drugs in the Veterinary Pharmacy.
- t. The Licensee shall be responsible for any Bio-Medical/other waste generated by the Veterinary Pharmacy and shall be responsible for disposal of the same as per Govt. Rules and Regulations.

5. General

- a. In case negotiation is necessary with regard to clarification of terms & conditions of the license or modification thereof, the College will not entertain any association of the traders and such negotiations should be sought by the licensee alone and no collective representation shall be entertained.
- b. In case of breach of terms & conditions, the College shall give 15 days' notice to the licensee to rectify the breach, after which appropriate action for cancellation of license may be initiated. In case the Licensee fails to perform

or commits breach of any of the obligations under the deed, the College shall without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the licensee may terminate the license in whole or in part.

- c. That the licensee shall comply with all the rules and regulations of the College/University as made applicable from time to time.
- d. In case of any misconduct on the part of the Licensee, the agreement will be terminated without assigning any reason and without any notice.
- e. Recovery of credit, if any, will be the sole responsibility of the Licensee.
- f. Any other conditions imposed by the College/University regarding allotment/termination/enhancement of license deed will equally be applicable to the Licensee.

VI. FORCE MAJEURE

Force Majeure means an event beyond the control of the Licensee and not involving the Licensee's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such event may include, but are not limited to, war or revolution, fire, floods, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes.

If a *Majeure* situation arises, the Licensee shall promptly notify the College in writing of such condition and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by the College, in writing, the Licensee shall continue to perform its obligations under the License Deed as far as is reasonably practical and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance of obligations not prevented by the *Force Majeure* event.

VII. DISPUTE SETTLEMENT

All questions, disputes and differences arising under and out of, or in connection with the License Deed shall be referred to the sole arbitration by an arbitrator appointed under the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 by the Vice-Chancellor, PVNRTVU, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad whose decision shall be final and binding on both the parties. The venue for the arbitration proceedings shall be Hyderabad.

All disputes shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Courts at Hyderabad.

Terms of Reference for Inspection and Monitoring Committee

In terms of provisions contained in this Tender Document, the terms of reference of Inspection and Monitoring Committee constituted by the University will be as follows:

- a. Whether drugs, medicines etc. being stocked & sold in the Veterinary Pharmacy are in conformity with the inventory list provided by the University.
- b. What is the minimum quantum of stock of each category of drugs, medicines etc. being maintained to ensure their continuous availability?
- c. Evaluation of the authenticity or genuineness of the quality of medicine being dispensed.
- d. Whether adequate storage facilities are being utilized in relation to proper stocking of medicines, provision of adequate cold storage & maintenance of cold chain of such drugs as prescribed by the manufacturers of such drugs.
- e. Appraisal of procedure for weeding out of expired medicines and its timely implementation.
- f. Whether the medicines dispensed are as per prescriptions of the Doctors or staff on duty.
- g. Whether the quantity and quality of man power being maintained in the Veterinary Pharmacy is adequate and as per instructions of the University and assurance given by the Licensee.
- h. Whether the presence of qualified pharmacists/staff is being maintained during working hours to ensure proper dispensing of drugs.
- i. Whether the number of dispensing counters is adequate.
- j. To assess the time taken by the vendor in satisfactory dispensing/return of prescribed medicines, which should be bare minimum
- k. To inspect the documents related to procurement of stock, its maintenance & sale.
- l. To check whether unused medicines, returned in sealed condition by animal owners/attendants are taken back by the licensee together with corresponding refund record.
- m. To check whether instructions issued by the University from time to time under various provisions of license deed are being continually adhered to by the licensee.
- n. To check whether any of the other agreed performance obligations of licensee as covered in the tender are being performed by the licensee to the satisfaction of the University.
- o. The aforesaid terms of reference of the said Committee are illustrative and not exhaustive. The Committee will be at liberty to check on any other aspect as deemed fit by it, for appraisal of functioning of the said Veterinary Pharmacy.
