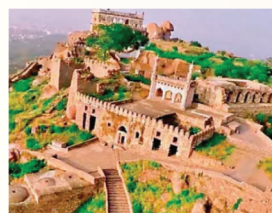
VENUE

This symposium will include Keynote address and lead paper presentations by eminent speakers. Besides, there would be oral and poster presentations by the participants in the following technical sessions:

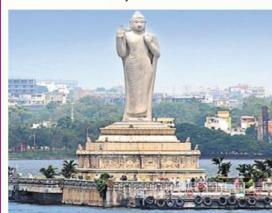
1. **Advanced Diagnostics for One Health Threats**
