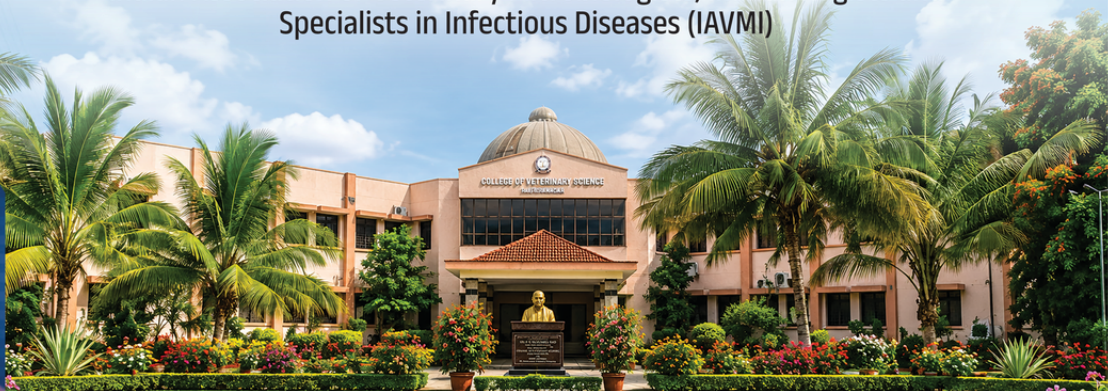

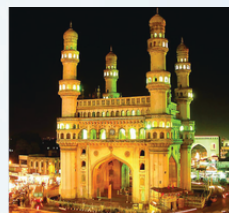

TRANSPORT AND ACCOMODATION

The College of Veterinary Science, Rajendranagar, is well connected to all major transport hubs in Hyderabad. It is located approximately 18 km from Rajiv Gandhi International Airport, 14 km from Nampally Railway Station, 20–22 km from Secunderabad railway station, 15 km from the MGBS Bus Station. Convenient taxi, cab, and public transport services are available for easy access to the venue. Hence, the organizing committee suggests that delegates make their own transport arrangements (for example, Ola, Uber, Rapido, etc.) to avoid inconvenience in waiting.

Paid accommodation will be provided in the University Guest Houses on first-come, first-served basis, subject to availability. Early registration and confirmation of participation are strongly recommended to ensure a smooth and comfortable experience. The registration fee, to and fro travelling, and accommodation expenses must be borne by the delegates attending the conference.

Abstracts highlighting the presenting author should be typed in MS Word, Times New Roman, 12-point font, and not exceeding 250 words. The last date for the submission of abstracts is December 10, 2026, through the e-mail: iavmicon2027@gmail.com. Acceptance of the abstract for oral/poster presentation will be communicated by e-mail. Poster(s) of 4 (W) × 3 (L) ft size on flex material with title, name of the author(s), address of the institute, objectives, materials & methods, results, and conclusions should be displayed.
